### GRANT OF WAIVER CERTIFICATE

**Please apply only to the Jurisdiction of Consulate General of India, Atlanta (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, Tennessee, US Virgin Islands).**

In order to enable the Embassy to issue a "**WAIVER CERTIFICATE**", for the purpose of immigration (conversion of J1 Visa to H1), it will be necessary for the applicant to obtain clearance directly from the authorities concerned in India, namely:

1. The State Government (Department of Home)
2. Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resources Development, Shastri Bhavan, New Delhi
3. The concerned passport office from which the application obtained passport to come abroad.

#### Instructions:

1. The applicant should fill in details in the enclosed "**Statement**" and "**Affidavit**".
2. Four copies of "**Statement**" and "**Affidavit**" should be **notarized**. All the copies of the statement and affidavit, **original passport** and [Miscellaneous Services Form](#) should be sent to the Embassy for attestation with a fee of US \$60.00, in the form of a **certified check or money order payable to Embassy of India**. **A self addressed stamped envelope** may be sent for returning the three sets of attested documents and passport. Applicants also need to send one USA address.
3. The applicant should then send one set each, directly to the authorities in India, with a request to grant NORI (No Obligation to Return to India) certificate.
4. After the NORIs have been obtained, the applicant should forward his/her passport and copies of the clearance along with **Case Number (Case Number should be obtained by the applicant directly from the U.S. Department of State)** to the Embassy/Consulate with a fee of US \$20.00 and a self addressed stamped envelope for return mail. The Embassy (Consulates) will issue WAWIER CERTIFICATE and forward it to the U.S. Department of State under intimation to the applicant. The concerned U.S. Authority will notify the applicant directly regarding its acceptance which usually takes 4-6 weeks.

**It should be clearly understood that the responsibility of getting the clearance from the authorities in India rests with the applicant.**

**The Embassy of India will not be in a position to undertake the job of reminding the authorities.**

**PERSONAL CHECKS/CREDIT CARDS NOT ACCEPTED; CASH is accepted only at the Consular Counter.**
